Welcome back for our final term together in Year 3. This is a very busy term for us with lots of exciting things coming up.

This term we shall be looking at plays and dialogues; a range of fiction texts; non-chronological reports and poetry in our literacy sessions. Handwriting practise will continue to focus on joined cursive writing, linking to our spelling objectives. Please continue reading regularly at home, across a wide range of genres and record your achievements in the reading records.

Our main maths topics this term are: geometry (properties of shapes) and measurement of time and capacity. We will continue to practise quick mental recall of times tables 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10, including division facts. This is something that can be practised at home to aid the children's skills and build their confidence. Homework tasks will continue to be set weekly on MyMaths to support these key skills, as well as to revise the topics that we have been learning in class that week.
