## Review of our school rules

We would like to update our school rules to:



**What do you remember learning about most (in this class or other classes)?**

**We have found that our pupils especially enjoy learning through practical experiences, useful methods of learning maths, music and topic (particularly the Great Fire of London in year 2 and the Roman battle in year 4). We look forward more of these experiences this year!**

Class 1: Jack and the Beanstalk (class R assembly); The Shining Star (nativity); reading and painting

Class 2: Part whole models in maths; the Great Fire of London; making a gingerbread man and making clay cups

Class 3: The Stone Age; the Great Fire of London and Japan (origami)

Class 4: The Great Fire of London and learning to play the cornet

Class 5: The Stone Age; the Great Fire of London; Roman battle; thousands, tens and ones; learning spellings

Class 6: History as we do it for a long time and it's fun; music with Mr Hunt and Mrs Rock; Roman battle; fractions (big subject with lots of different types of fractions)

**What will help you with your learning this year?**

Class 1: Looking at and listening carefully to our teacher; practising our reading; keep practising to get better

Class 2: We like our worry dolls

Class 3: Learning our times tables; songs to help us learn facts

Class 4: The right level of work to support and challenge

Class 5: Handwriting practise; outdoor learning; more art and drama

Class 6: Work with focus; challenging tasks; being prepared

Some ideas include:

Sculptures; music and art; night pictures with stars and moons; whole class picture; painting on wood; clay; models of historic landmark; canvases; fabric prints; big draw mural; tissue stained glass windows; one big class papier mache model linked to class topic; nature themed art.
